Llys Emlyn Williams is a supported housing scheme in Holywell providing 24-hour support for those aged between 16 and 35. The scheme houses twelve service users' males and females.

Bodhyfryd is within the same project, this is five bedded and supports 16-20 service users' male and females.

The Quay Project is a supported housing scheme in Greenfield providing 24-hour support for those aged between 16 and 35. The scheme houses sixteen service users' males and females. We have a complex needs project house based in Greenfield which houses 4 Male/Females between the ages of 16 and 25. Dispersed throughout Flintshire, we also have 12 self-contained flats as part of the Quay Project.

Who are we looking for?

- You will have great people skills and excellent communication skills.
- You will have empathy with homeless people and have a passion for wanting to provide safe and secure accommodation to some of the most vulnerable in society.
- You will have a positive and dynamic attitude to working in what can be a challenging environment at times.
- You will understand what delivering excellent customer service is and a commitment to doing so.

Key Responsibilities of Role:

- Delivering a wrap-around service that prepares service users to live independently.



- Providing a continuous and consistent approach to support for vulnerable adults, helping them make the transition into independent living and advising them on re-housing options.
- Identifying service user's individual needs and risks and support them to address these issues through a comprehensive support/move on package.
- Providing support with budgeting and money management, including welfare benefits.
- Providing support in a practical way, with regards to education, training and employment and day to day living.

For this role you will require an Enhanced DBS check, which we pay for.

Shift patterns will vary dependant on scheme, but shifts will include days, evenings, weekends, sleep in's, waking nights and lone working, on a rota basis.
