The Quay Project is a supported housing scheme in Greenfield providing 24-hour support for 16–35-year-olds. The scheme houses 16 service user's males and females. We have a complex needs project house based in Greenfield which houses 4 Male/Females between the ages of 16-25. Dispersed throughout Flintshire, we also have 12 self-contained flats as part of the Quay Project.

We provide accommodation with support packages tailored to the individual needs of our clients. Our aim is to develop people's independent living skills to enable them to move on into their forever homes We also provide a programme of activities and accredited training opportunities to support people to develop the skills they need to successfully move on with their lives.

### **Key Responsibilities of Role;**

- Staff deliver a wrap-around service that prepares families with children to live independently.
- Provide a continuous and consistent approach to support for vulnerable families helping them make the transition into independent living and advising them on re-housing options.
- Identify service user's individual needs and risks and support them to address these issues through a comprehensive support/move on package.
- Provide support with budgeting and money management, including welfare benefits.
- Provide support in a practical way, with regards to education, training, employment, and day to day living.
- Liaise with a variety of external agencies.

### **Skills and Qualifications required for the role;**

- You will have experience of working face-to-face with vulnerable groups in a complex needs setting (including adults with alcohol/substance misuse).
- Experience of key-working and outcomes monitoring.
- Knowledge of the issues facing homeless people.
- Ability to work on own initiative and under pressure, as well as part of a team.
- This role requires flexibility along with enthusiastic, self-motivated, and creative individuals.
- You will have excellent communication skills, both verbal and written, with the ability to produce individual support plans and other written reports and monitoring information as required.
- Knowledge of financial procedures and budgeting controls and knowledge of the benefits system.
- A recognised qualification in housing, family welfare, social care, supported housing or NVQ2 in a relevant discipline and/ or relevant experience.

Duties will include Evening and weekend shifts as well as days.

**For this role you will require an Enhanced DBS check, which we pay for.**
