Key Responsibilities of Role;

- Staff deliver a wrap-around service that prepares families with children to live independently.
- Provide a continuous and consistent approach to support for vulnerable families helping them make the transition into independent living and advising them on re-housing options.
- Identify service user's individual needs and risks and support them to address these issues through a comprehensive support/move on package.
- Provide support with budgeting and money management, including welfare benefits.
- Provide support in a practical way, with regards to education, training, employment and day to day living.
- Liaise with a variety of external agencies.
- You will have experience of working face-to-face with vulnerable groups in a complex needs setting (including adults with alcohol/substance misuse).
- Experience of key-working and outcomes monitoring.
- Knowledge of the issues facing homeless people.
- Ability to work on own initiative and under pressure, as well as part of a team.
- This role requires flexibility along with enthusiastic, self-motivated and creative individuals.
- You will have excellent communication skills, both verbal and written, with the ability to produce individual support plans and other written reports and monitoring information as required.
- Knowledge of financial procedures and budgeting controls and knowledge of the benefits system.

Skills and Qualifications required for the role;

A recognised qualification in housing, family welfare, social care, supported housing or NVQ2 in a relevant discipline and/ or relevant experience.

Duties will include evening and weekend shifts as well as days.

For this role you will require an Enhanced DBS check, which we pay for.
