Skills and Qualifications required for the role:

- A minimum of 2 years post qualifying experience following an Electrical Testing Qualification - C&G 2391 or equivalent.
- EAL Level 3 NVQ and AM2 Qualification or Equivalent in Electrical Installation/Engineering or has been an electrical QS for a certificated business within the last 2 years.
- You will hold as a minimum C&G 2382 - 18th Edition or higher.
- Have records of ongoing Continuing Professional Development (CPD).
- Have good IT skills and competency. Training will be provided on Group specific IT systems.
- Can complete electrical test certificates electronically and review to a high standard.
- You will be part of an on-call rota.
